Mitsubishi Electric completes major LED installation for FC Spartak Moscow.

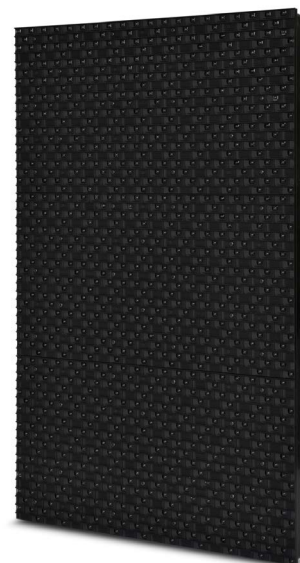

Mitsubishi Electric has completed the installation of its Diamond Vision LED screens at a new home stadium of Spartak football club, Otkrytiye Arena in Moscow. The two 172 square meter screens are placed at the opposite ends of the 42,000-seat capacity stadium, at its northern and southern stands.

Working in cooperation with Armo-Systems and Avilex of Moscow, Mitsubishi Electric has installed two 17.92 m to 9.6 m screens consisting of its new Diamond Vision ODX8 LED screen modules. Each 16:9 aspect ratio screen offers a native resolution of 1600 by 960 pixels and brightness of 6,000 cd/m² delivering high quality images in bright daylight conditions.

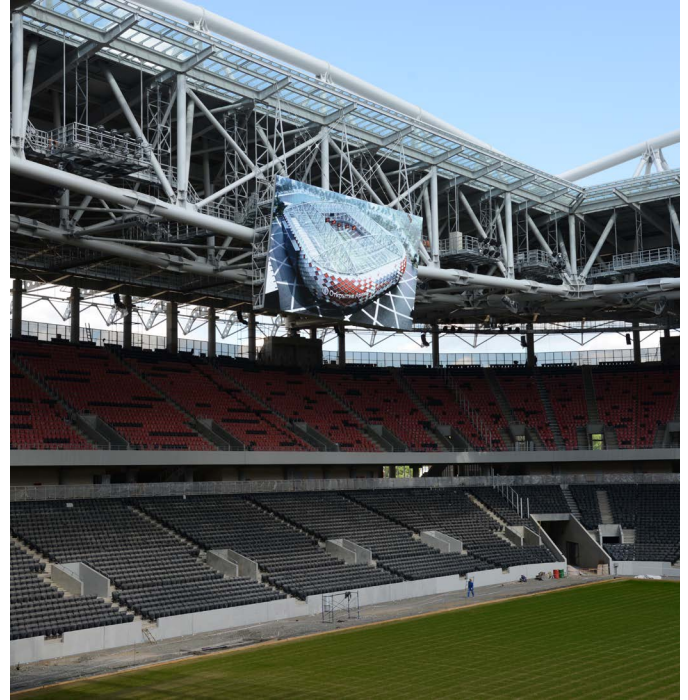

Mitsubishi's Diamond Vision ODX8 is the latest product in the Diamond Vision range developed in response to the increasing demand for LED screens in the global market. With its new 8 mm Delta cell (LED type) and innovative technology, Mitsubishi has been able to maintain the balance between unmatched image quality, reliability and competitive pricing.

The installation meets the FIFA requirements and guidelines, ensuring that the Stadium will feature screen performance at a world-class level. The Stadium has the state-of-the-art equipment and is built to meet modern safety and comfort requirements, which will benefit both players and fans. As such, the Otkrytiye Arena can receive the top level certification from the Russian Football Union and UEFA and will be able to host not only the Russian Championship, but also Premier League matches. The new sports venue, which will be a host of the 2017 Confederations Cup and the 2018 World Cup games, will open its doors on September 5, 2014.

It is reported that with Mitsubishi Diamond Vision LED screens Otkrytiye Arena will have the largest stadium screens in Russia.
